1,222 cows classified at all locations.

General Comments

Classifiers noted that the cows were very calm and easy going.

Classifiers also noted that the farms were really good working environments with great people to work with and calm, easy going cows.

7 NEW EXCELLENT COWS (90+ points)

3 cows over the age of 7 were scored EX-90.

2 of them being high-performing cows, nearing 200K lbs of lifetime production.

MCCARTY-BC AICON 31956 scored EX-90 for the second time making her EX-90-2E.

123 VERY GOOD COWS (85-89 points)

11 first lactation cows scored Very Good

ELM-KAN-MFF PARFECT 66588 classified 86 after scoring 82 as a fresh heifer in July.

HIGH GENOMIC INDEX COWS

ELM-KAN-MFF PARFECT 67669 classified VG-85 (max) in her first lactation. She is 2780 GTPI and over +2.0 on PTAT. She has a CUMULUS daughter that is 3008 GTPI.

The 3 highest GTPI cows scored were all PARFECT daughters between 2882 and 2904 GTPI.
